Travel without the weather worry

Friday, February 8th:

Departure from Newark Int'l (AM) – Mostly cloudy skies with light snow squalls possible. Temperatures in the upper 20s to around 30. Weather should create only minor departure delays.

Arrival at Miami – Mostly sunny skies and only slight chance for stray/isolated shower in the afternoon hours. High temperature in the mid-80s range, several degrees above normal for this time of the year.

Saturday, February 9th:

Morning temperatures in the low 60s with partly cloudy skies turning mostly cloudy as the day progresses. High temperature should reach 80-81 with a 55% chance for light rain showers, primarily during the afternoon or early evening hours. Rainfall amounts will generally be less than 0.10". Temperatures by the evening hours will only cool to around the low 70s.

Sunday, February 10th:

Mostly cloudy skies once again throughout the day with 70%-75% chance for rain showers on-and-off throughout the morning and afternoon hours. Rainfall amounts should be less than 0.20", however. High temperatures in the upper 70s, which is close to normal for this time of the year. A bit windier on Sunday with sustained winds in the 10-15MPH gusting to 20-25MPH.

Monday – Wednesday (Feb 11th-13th):

High pressure will be building in across Florida, producing mostly sunny skies and clear nights these next three days. High temperatures will be in the low 80s with Wednesday being the warmest day and readings around 84. Morning low temperatures will be in the 70-72 range. No chance of rain from Monday to Wednesday.

Thursday, February 14th:

Clouds and some rain showers will be working their way back into the region, although temperatures will still be quite warm (and humid) with readings topping out in the upper 80s. Best chance for rain showers will be late afternoon and into the evening hours.

Friday, February 15th:

Mostly cloudy skies with rain showers likely (65-70% chance). Cooler temperatures in the lower 70s as a result. Morning low temperatures in the low 60s.

Departure from MLA (afternoon): The light, scattered showers could create some very minor take-off delays.

Arrival at EWR (early evening): Mostly cloudy skies with abnormally mild temperatures in the low 50s by touch-down. Rain showers later in the evening, but they should hold off until after arrival. Only minor weather-related arrival delays anticipated.
